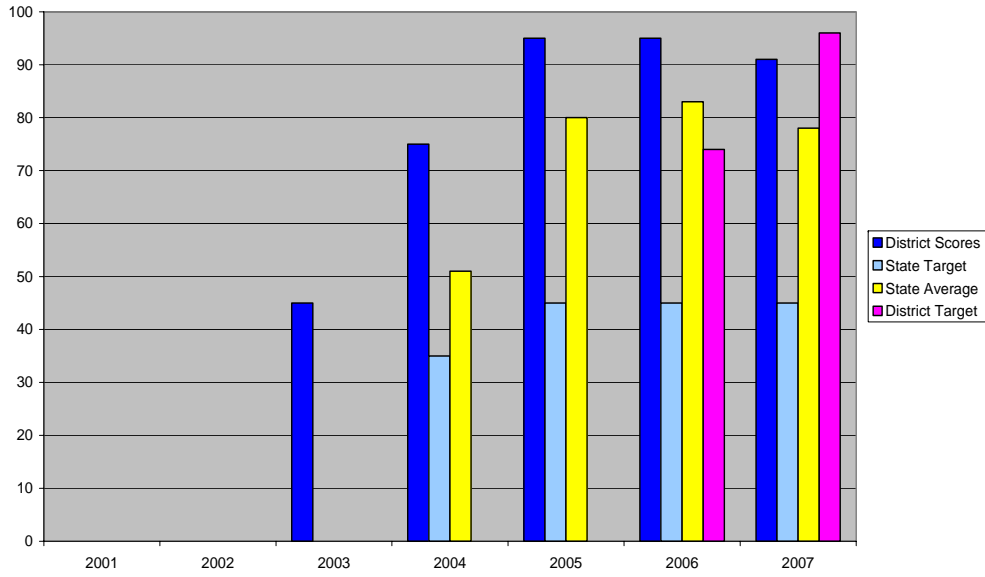

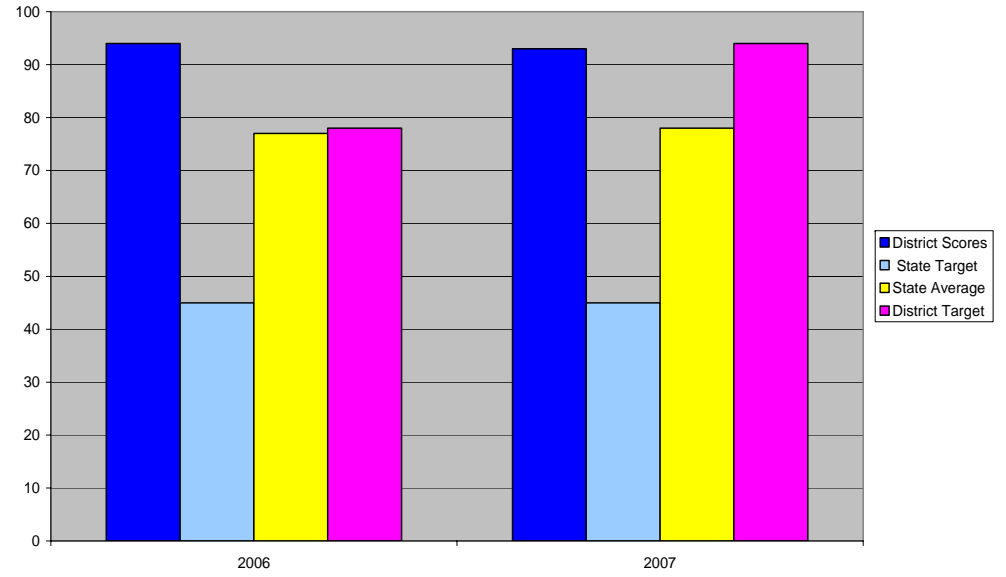

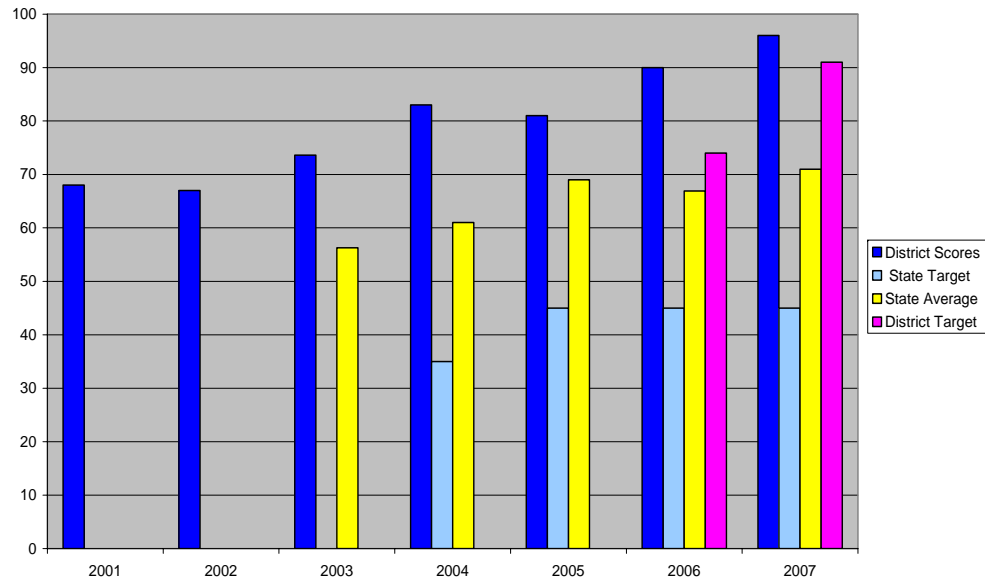

Grade 3



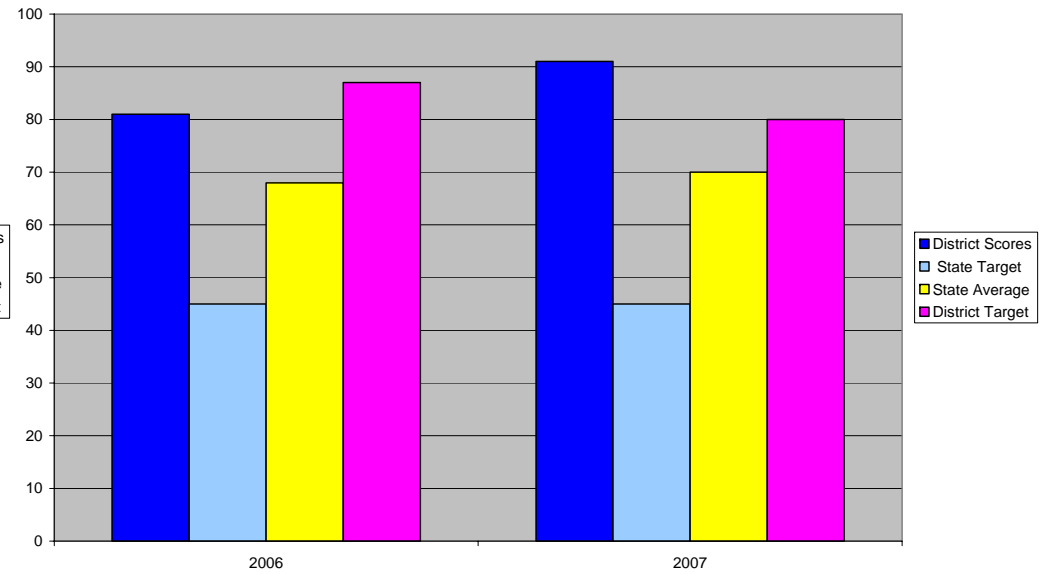

Grade 4



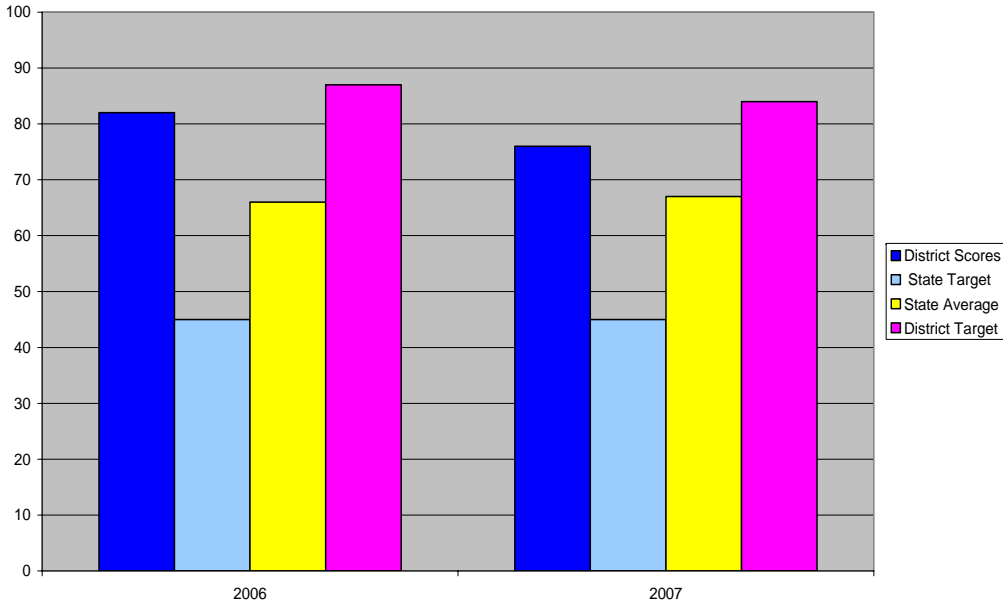

Grade 5



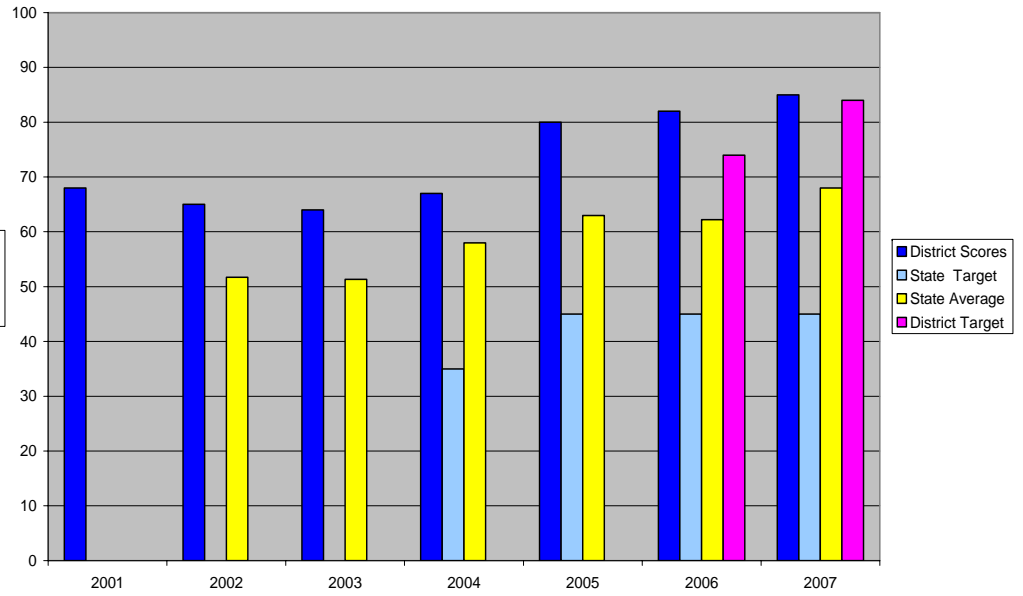

Grade 6



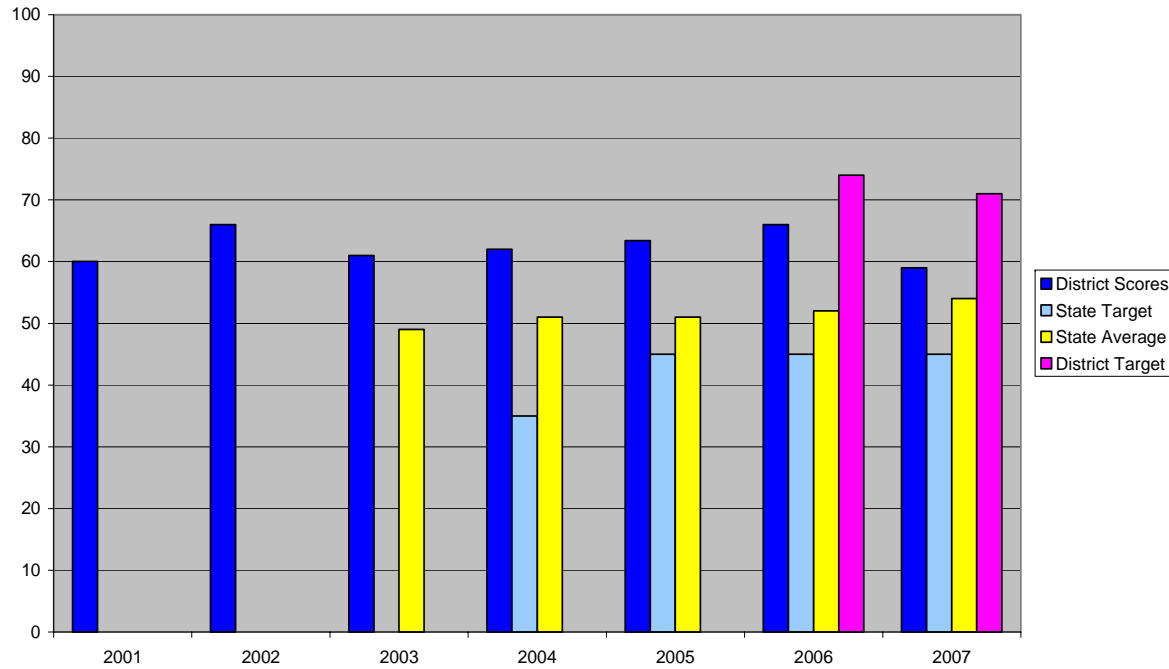

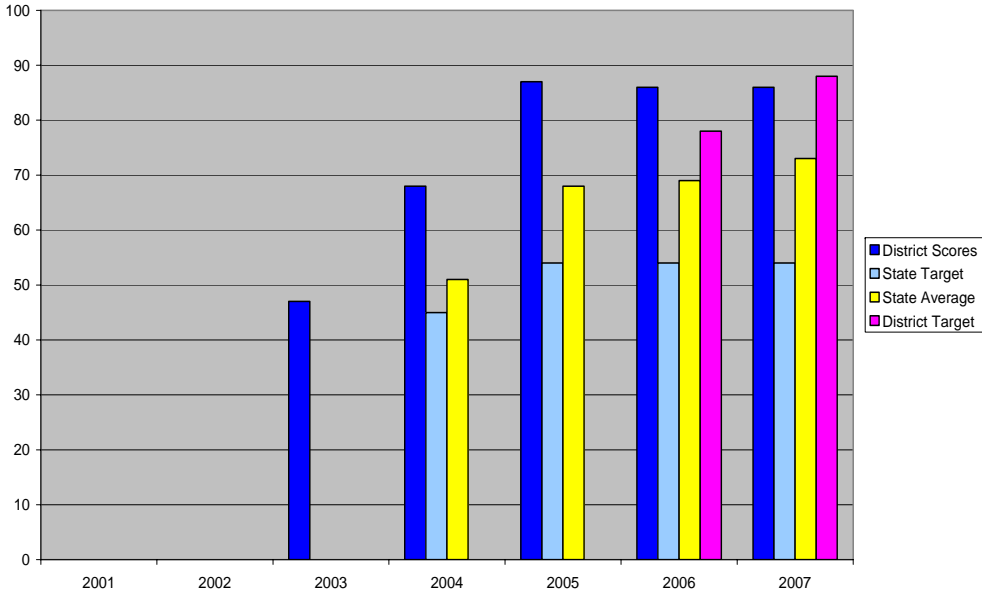

Grade 8



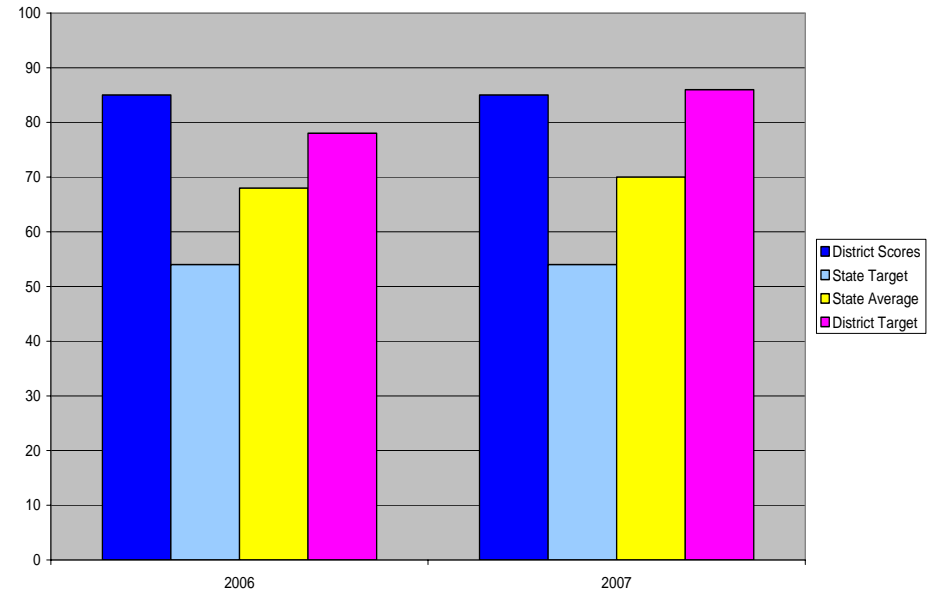

Grade 11



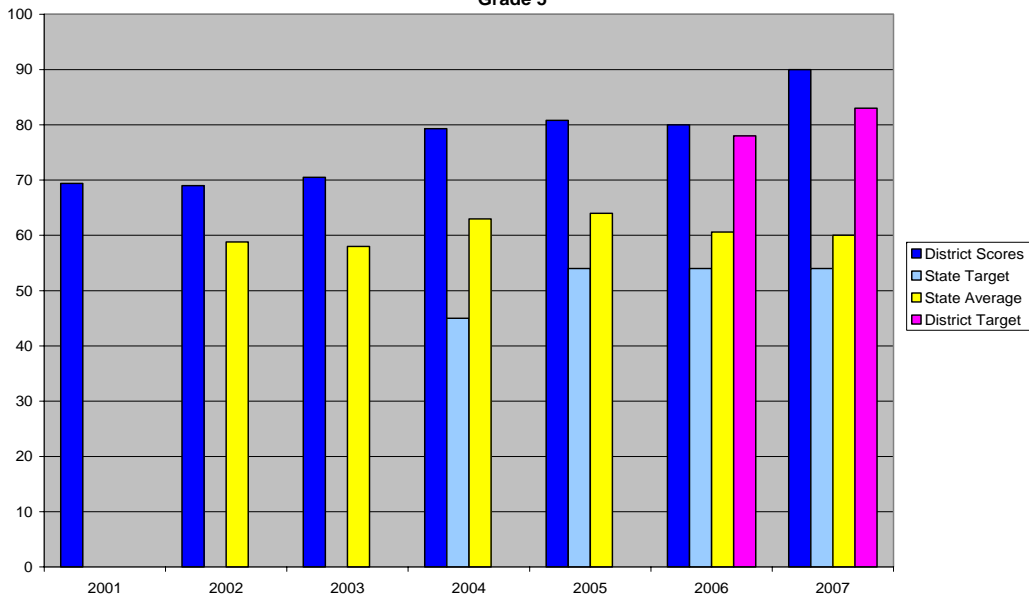

Grade 3



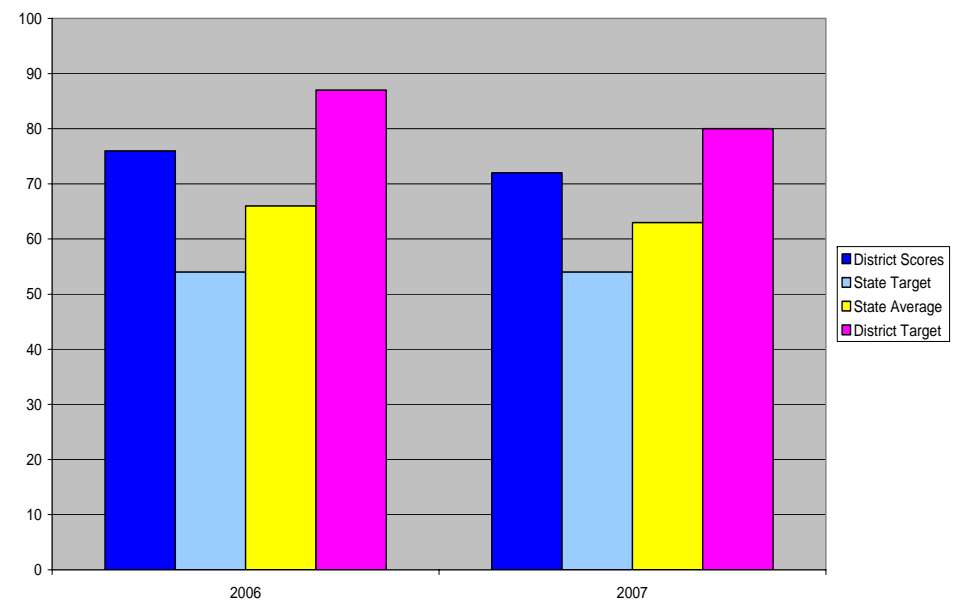

Grade 4



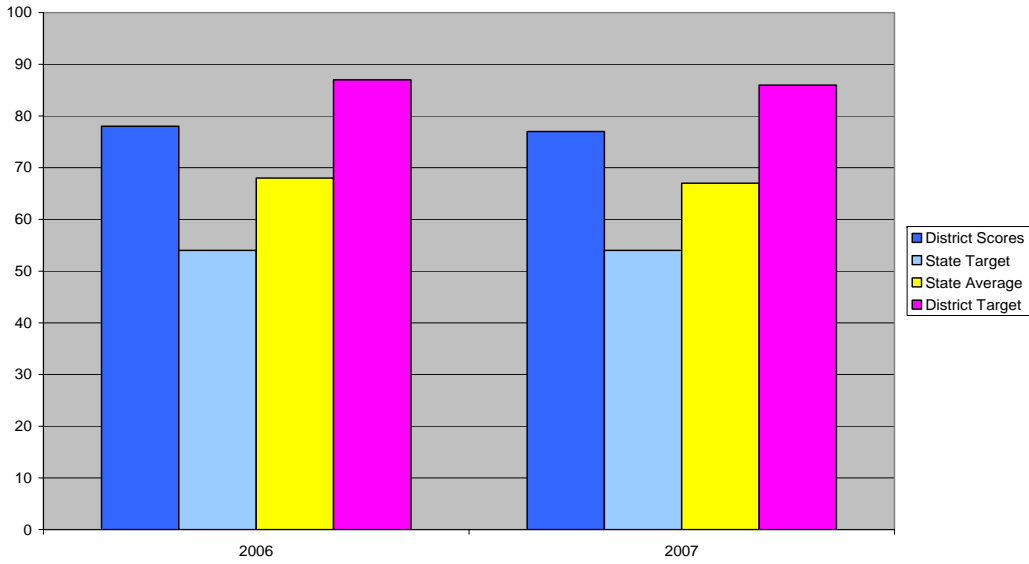

Grade 5



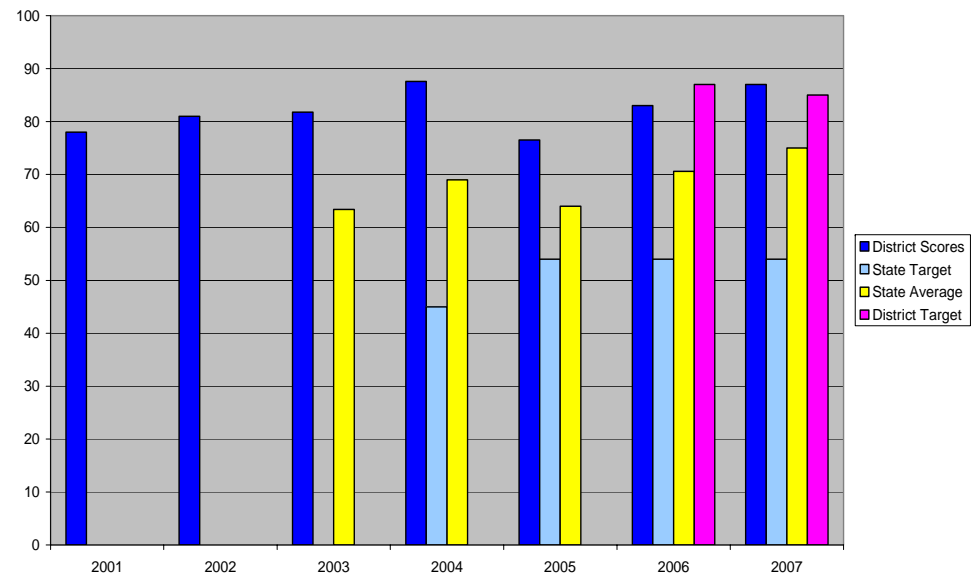

Grade 6



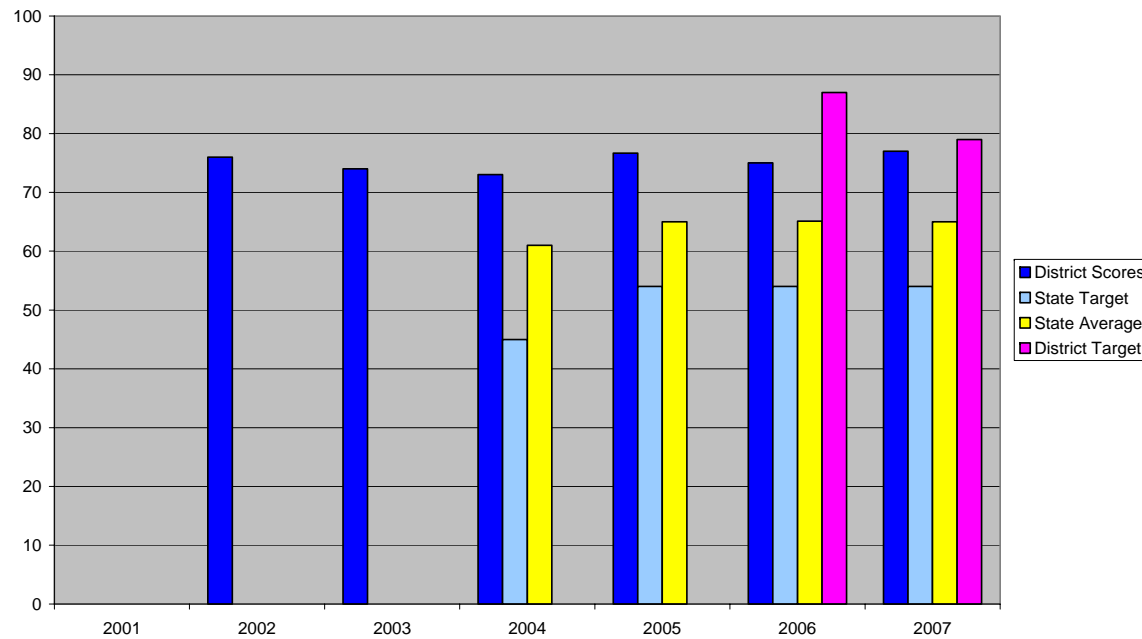

Grade 7



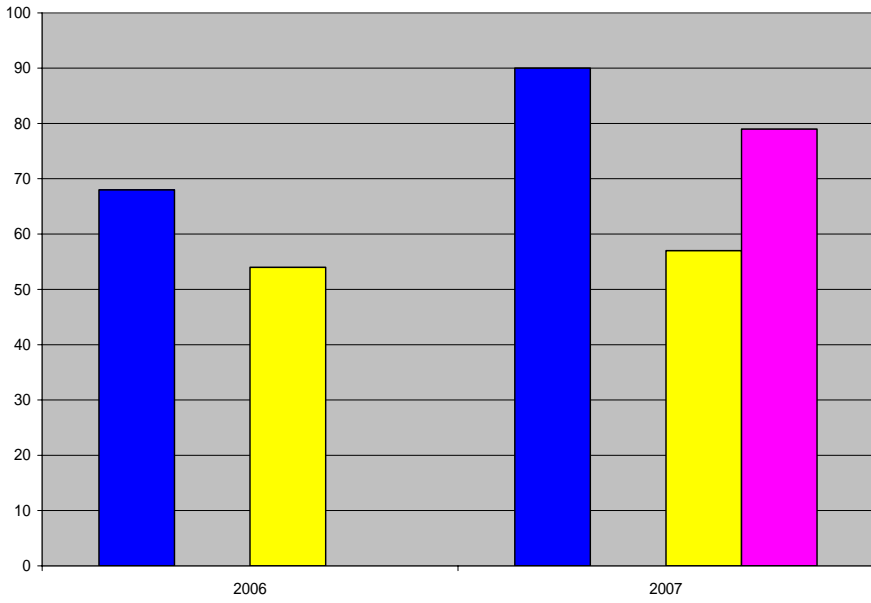

Grade 8



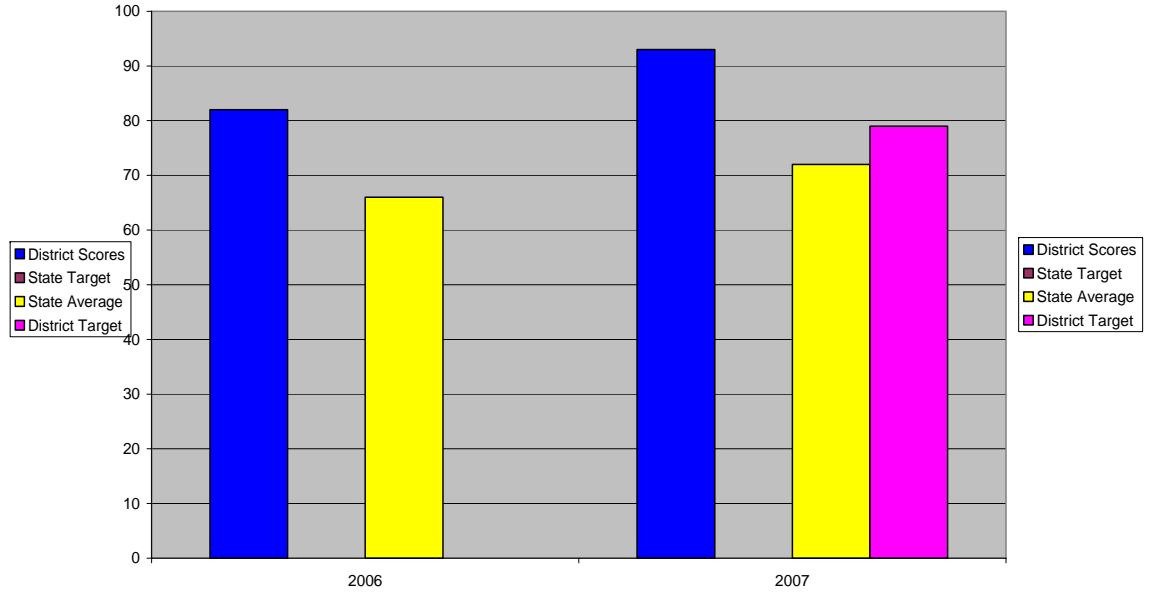
