Cost: \$135 per session

This price reflects an increase in time (from 1 hour to 1 ½ hours.)

Students may sign up for 1 or 2 sessions—of the same or different subject areas.

Kindergarten (Grade level 08 – 09 school year) Taught by Mrs. Gercie

This course allows our Kindergarteners the opportunity to practice and maintain their Reading and Math Skills for their first grade debut.

9:00—11:00 AM

Cost: \$180 (Minimum of 9 students needed for class to run.)

Preschool (Grade level for 08-09 school year) Taught by Miss Mickey

This course allows our incoming Kindergarteners the opportunity to develop and/or practice their Reading and Math skills for their Kindergarten debut. This session also allows these youngsters to become acquainted with their new school.

9:00—11:00 AM

Cost: \$180 (Minimum of 9 students needed for class to run.)

Sunday Taught by Miss Foreman

Small, 45-minutes group instruction for those students who would like to continue to move through the program begun during the year. Schedule will be based on grouping students on similar levels.

8:00 AM—12:00 P M

Cost: \$67.50 (Minimum of 5 students needed for each 45 minute class to run.)

Earobics/FastForward

Individual ½ hour computer-based instruction for those students who would like to continue to work on programs begun during the year.

Cost: \$20 (Minimum of 2, Maximum of 20 per ½ hour.)
