# First Day - Arrival and Dismissal

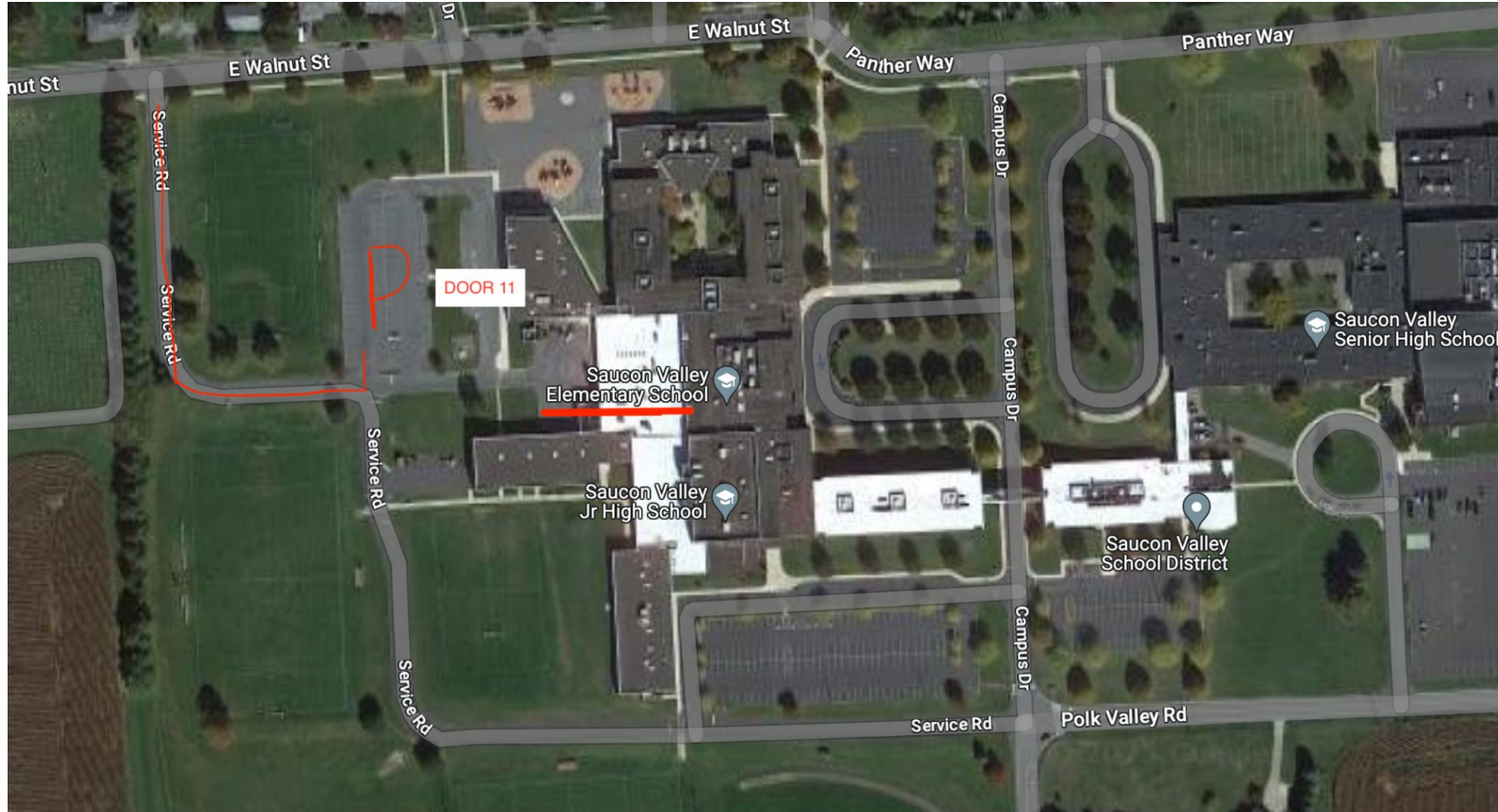
- Students should be dropped off at **Door 11** in the back of the elementary building next to playground.

- **School Readiness Skills**

- Express emotions in socially acceptable ways
- Develop positive coping skills
- Interact with peers and adults in a socially acceptable way
- Engage in communication and use complete sentences
- Ask for help appropriately
- Explore and ask questions
- Attend to a task for increasing periods of time

- **Academic Readiness Skills**

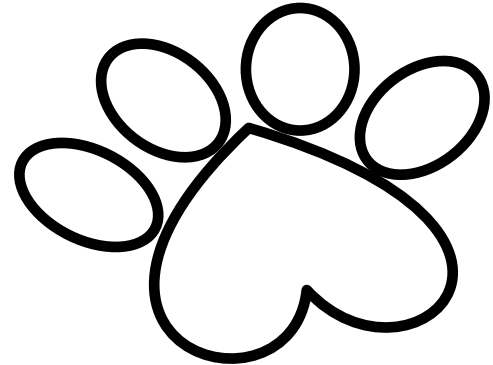
- Book handling skills
- Concepts about print (left to right, turning pages, etc.)
- Recognize and produce rhyming words
- Ask and answer questions about texts
- Practice recognizing letters and numbers
- Identify shapes
- Identify colors
