School officials are authorized to search a student's motor vehicle parked on school property when there is reasonable suspicion that the student is violating a law, Board policy or school rules, or poses a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the school population. *(See Saucon Valley School District Board Policy #226 Searches)*

1. Students may not park on school property unless vehicle is properly registered and displays the assigned parking permit. (Permit must be visible hanging from the front of the rearview mirror all times).
2. Students may not park within green lines, handicapped, staff parking, safety zones, reserved or visitor spaces.
3. Students may not drive diagonally across the lot (must stay in lanes).
4. Students are not permitted to visit their vehicle during school hours unless permission from the Principal or Assistant Principal is granted. ~ A hall monitor may be asked to escort the student ~
5. Students must obey the 15 mph speed limit at all times.
6. Students may not drive recklessly through the parking lot.
7. Ten or more tardies to school (excused or unexcused) will result in a two-week permit suspension plus an additional week for every day a student is late during the period of suspension. The parking tag will be held in the attendance office during the suspension and returned when suspension is lifted.
8. Students may not take other students off school property during school hours (Result: a 4-week permit suspension).
9. Students may not leave school without permission (Result: a 4-week permit suspension).
10. Any vehicle parked illegally or without a tag will be subject to a fine at the driver's expense.
11. Truancy, disciplinary problems, and academic problems may lead to a suspension of parking privileges despite having paid the registration fee.
12. If a student receives two warnings for any of the above infractions and does not correct the reason for the warning, then a ticket will be issued by the Lower Saucon Police Department.

***Parking violations will result in a \$10.00 parking ticket. Violations could lead to vehicle being towed and permanent suspension of parking privileges.**
