## Connect to your “in school” class

- Use of Schoology and other apps to connect

## Digital Citizenship...social rules for online learning

- Display of full name- first name and last name
- Video ON- showing your face, make sure your background is appropriate
- MUTE microphone when not speaking
- Use features- raise hand, thumbs up, chat to ask questions

**Can be either  
synchronous or  
asynchronous, or both**

**Must log into Schoology,  
attend Zoom, and  
complete all work for the  
class (including  
homework)**

**VIRTUAL**

All students will receive the same curriculum, assignments may vary, same learning experience



# GRADES

Official grades are housed in PowerSchool

All grades count! There will be NO changes as happened in the Spring

Check syllabus in regards to midterms and final exam percentages

Report Cards will be available on Power School- we will not be sending or distributing in school

Courses “in person” and “virtual” receive the same weighting and students will be required to show evidence of their learning

Students must follow due dates and communicate absences/missed classes as per teacher guidelines. Students who are virtual must still follow rules for absences if missing access and completion components.
